Q & A: "About Marriage and Same-Sex Unions; Between Man and Woman"

Why is a same-sex union not equivalent to a marriage? Several reasons; same-sex union contradicts the nature of marriage; it is not based on the natural complimentarily of male and female; it cannot cooperate with God to create new life; natural purpose of sexual union cannot be achieved by a same-sex union.

Persons in same-sex unions cannot enter into a true conjugal union; therefore, it is wrong to equate their relationship to marriage.

### TRICKY TRAY AUCTION



# En Octubre, no dejes de rezar el Rosario




