**Reflecting On The Gospel** - Have you ever wanted something? Then received it and realized it wasn't what you thought it was. Maybe you were disappointed; maybe you were thrilled - more than you thought you'd be.

In today's Gospel, the Apostles ask something of Jesus, and Jesus wants to be sure they know just what it is they are asking. The Apostles ask Jesus to increase their faith. Jesus response is to be sure the Apostles understand how powerful faith can be. He says even a small amount of faith is powerful enough to uproot a tree and plant it again in the sea.
