#### **Apostles' Creed**

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth,  
**and** in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,  
**who** was conceived **by** the Holy Spirit,  
born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died and was buried; he descended **into hell;**

on the third day he rose again **from the dead;**  
he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand  
of **God** the Father **almighty;**  
**from there** he will come to judge the living and the dead.  
I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church,  
the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.
