

Gospel Reflection

Every so often in Scripture we find the Disciples jockeying for premium positions on the totem pole. This weekend James and John, sons of Zebedee, baldly request the most prestigious positions in the pecking order - to sit on either side of Jesus (Interestingly, in another passage we learn that their mother instigates this graceless and clueless request - testifying to the fact that family pressure can be just as misguided and sinful as peer pressure); Jesus' response to such inane requests is always clear and consistent; we may accuse Him of ambiguity and lacking clarity in other teachings, but in this one, there is no mistaking where He stands, ...whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all. This is Good News for Jesus. Is it Good News for us?


