

Safeguarding Children and Addressing Abuse

THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IS BATTLING SEXUAL ABUSE

While most media focus over the past ten or more years has been on the incidents of sexual abuse within the Church, little has been said about the many positive steps that the Catholic Church has taken to address the issue. Dioceses across the country, and especially the Archdiocese of Newark, have instituted compassionate outreach to victims and support services, training and background checks for staff and volunteers, training for children and youth, codes of conduct, reporting requirements to civil authorities, independent Review Boards to investigate allegations

and recommend actions under Canon law for offenders, as well as other initiatives.

To date, the Catholic Church is the only youth-serving organization in the country - private or public -- to undertake such a comprehensive program to create and promulgate safe environments for children and young people.

Independent auditors from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have found the Archdiocese of Newark to be fully compliant with the requirements of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People in every year since audits began in 2003.

Archbishop's Annual Appeal --- Making a Difference

The Respect Life Office of the Archdiocese of Newark promotes the Catholic Church's teaching on the respect, care and protection of human life from conception to natural death.

Next April, the Respect Life Office will sponsor the annual Pro-Life Youth Rally at Seton Hall University. Over 700 High School students from all over the state are expected to attend this rally, which will feature motivational speakers, music and Mass.

The Respect Life Office also works with crisis pregnancy centers to direct people to proper prenatal care and information when faced with a crisis pregnancy.

In September 2010, the Respect Life Office and parish-based pro-life supporters launched the John Paul II Committee, a congress of local pro-life groups. The committee is named after Blessed John Paul II, author of the landmark encyclical, "The Gospel of Life." His untiring efforts on behalf of life inspired many to join the cause. This group is already established in Bergen and Union counties and is expanding to Essex and Hudson counties.

The Respect Life Office started Rachel's Vineyard retreats in 1997 to help men and women who have had an

abortion, find hope and healing. To date there have been 64 retreats healing 700 men and women.
